What are we perceiving ?

"If my people, who are called by my Name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land" (2 Chronicles 7.14)

There has been much prayer based on this verse of scripture over the past two decades and we have seen a huge increase in the prayer of the Church throughout Britain. During the same period there has been an increasing domination of secular humanist ideology and this has been manifest in a systematic de-Christianisation of our society.

We are now faced with utter confusion, acrimonious division and serious dysfunction at the very heart of our Government and nation; but before we point fingers at politicians and others, we must consider carefully who is responsible for the state of our nation. Scripture makes clear that the prosperity or collapse of a nation is directly determined by the spiritual orientation of its people – not the unbelieving citizens, but the people called by God's name.

So is God hearing the prayers of His people?

YES! and we are being truly humbled – not only by the inability of politicians to find the way through the perplexing checkmate of Brexit negotiations, but also by the inadequacies of our health and social services, our police forces, our schools, our local authorities and all those we expect to solve the problems in our nation. Having led the world in years gone by, we are now rendered helpless in the face of our inability to explain and address the ever-increasing distress and disorder generated by spiralling levels of mental ill health, especially in the young, uncontrollable anti-social and criminal activity, especially knife crime, worrying undercurrents of racial animosity and dangerous polarisation of political activism; and despite the claims of the Treasury we have a precariously balanced economy, which is vulnerable to collapse in the face of an unexpected disaster.

Are we really seeing an answer to our plea for God's mercy?

YES! "Those whom I [dearly and tenderly] love, I rebuke and discipline [showing them their faults and instructing them]; so be enthusiastic and repent [change your inner self – your old way of thinking, your sinful behaviour – seek God's will]" (Rev. 3.19 AMP). Like the Church at Laodicea, we as a nation are spiritually and morally bankrupt and blind, and our nakedness is being exposed to the world, which watches in bewilderment.

Brothers and Sisters in Christ, this is not a time for us, as followers of Jesus, to let our 'hands hang limp' in despondency or to 'shrink back' in defeat. This is a time for us to unite more determinedly, as the Body of Christ, and to pray more fervently that the Lord, in His kindness, will move us to a place of deeper repentance for our personal sin, the sin of the Church and the sin of the nation, of which we are a part. We do this in the real and confident hope that the God who calls us and this nation out of darkness will deliver and heal us to see His glorious light once again.

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Maranatha Community What Now?

We believe there is a renewed call emerging for our Community but its definition is not yet clear.

As we gathered and enjoyed united worship, prayer and fellowship on 2nd March in Leicester, our prayer was that we be ready for whatever the Lord intends for the Community. Our united declaration, in anticipation and preparation, is **'YES LORD!'**. We continue to listen, watch and pray attentively.

As we wait, we strongly encourage all members of the Maranatha Community to continue to be 'connectors', 'catalysts' and 'agents of integration'; praying and working for unity, renewal and healing in the places we live, work and worship.

A Prayer for this time

If we are to recognise and engage with the 'new thing' God is doing, we ourselves must be made new. 'Come Holy Spirit, touch our eyes, ears, hearts and minds. Release us from our old ways of being and re-form us to see, hear, love and discern as your risen Body in the world; and, as we are renewed, may we be open channels for a fresh release of your living water to those around us.'

Call to Prayer

Leaders of prayer networks and Houses of Prayer throughout the UK have been gathering to listen to God together for several We have experienced years. God's Spirit aligning our hearts and minds with His and, during a gathering at the beginning of this vear, there was aareement that a national call to prayer should be circulated. Please share this call to pray for our nation as widely as possible. Many will use this pattern for prayer at 12 noon daily.

In unity with Christians of all traditions, under the Lordship of Jesus Christ, we pray the Lord's prayer together with Psalm 23 over the UK. We also proclaim "Order! Order!" into the spiritual confusion over our Parliament and nation, if possible whilst ringing a bell. In unity we pray that Jesus is exalted as the Lamb of God over the nations.

There are several individuals, groups and ministries who have been prompted to proclaim the sovereignty of God accompanied by a sound - a trumpet or musical note - at intervals across the nation. We pray the Holy Spirit will bring into resonance and harmony all the voices raised to the Lord as a crescendo, cutting through the babble of the world, making way for the voice of the Lord to be heard.

British Values

Last year 'The Values Foundation' was formed by a group of individuals concerned about the influences now dominating our educational system. Its leadership includes Jews and Christians uniting to reassert the Judaeo-Christian foundations of our civilisation.
