Directions by road: From the North on M53, exit at Junc. 4, at the Clatterbridge roundabout. Take the second left onto Brimstage Rd, B5137. Continue to the first crossroads (traffic lights). Turn left into Church Road and continue into Bebington village (shops). Keep to this road until you get to lights at Bebington (Mersey Rail) Station. Carry straight on under the railway bridge. The church is not far after the bridge on the left, between Sandringham Close & Windsor Close. Turn into an alleyway just before the church which leads into the church car park. Arriving from the South on M53 exit at Junc. 4 and position yourself in the Bebington lane leading you off the Clatterbridge roundabout into Brimstage Road, B5137 (5th exit). Proceed as in the above directions.

By train (Mersey Rail): Get off at Bebington Station, go under the bridge towards Port Sunlight (as in the directions for cars) and St. John's is on the left as indicated above.
