Directions to St. Margaret's Church, Jarvis Road, Erdington, Birmingham, B23 5RR

By Car: Leave M6 at junction 6 (spaghetti), take A5127 North (Lichfield/Sutton Coldfield). Go up Gravelly Hill, bearing left at fork (300 yards). Continue for 2/3 mile to Six-ways roundabout. Take left-hand lane and B4142 (Summer Rd/Gravelly Lane). After ½ mile, go through traffic lights at Station Rd. Jarvis Rd is 3rd on left, after about 1/4 mile. Turn left. In 200 yards, turn left into St. Margaret's car park (tarmac at back of church).

Non-motorway (from East): From the A.38 or A453, aim for the A452 (Chester Road). The junction with the B.4142 has traffic lights and lies 100 yards north of Chester Road railway station / 1 mile south of the Beggar's Bush (at New Oscott /RC College). There is a Baptist Church at the junction. Turn west into B4142: Gravelly Lane. Jarvis Road is 3rd on the right, after ½ mile. St. Margaret's is 200 yards on the left. Turn in to car park at rear of the building.

By train: From Birmingham New Street station take local line for Lichfield (sometimes Four Oaks). Trains depart every 10/20 minutes on Saturday mornings and take 12 minutes to Erdington (e.g. depart 0955 arrives 1007). Alight at Erdington railway station, go down steps, turn **right** into Station Rd and go down to traffic lights. (Note: do **not** turn left, going under railway bridge up to another set of lights altogether). At lights (100 yds) cross Gravelly Lane and turn right along the same for about ¼ mile. Jarvis Rd is 3rd on the left. Turn left : St. Margaret's is 200 yds on left. - red brick building of modern design, with large stainless steel sheet cross on the tower. (Walk takes about 15 minutes).

By bus: Cross-suburb route 66 passes the church every 10 minutes. Radial routes (102, 104) from Birmingham city centre travel along the main road east of Erdington Station.
