25. Even in this world, you have become as I am. (1 Jn. 4:17)
26. I set you apart, placed my mark of ownership upon you, gave you the Holy Spirit in your heart as the guarantee of all I have for you. (2 Cor. 1:22).
27. You shall become like me,, for you shall see me as I am. (1 Jn. 3:2)
28. You shall see me face to face, and my name will be written on your forehead, and you shall reign with me for ever. (Rv. 22:4)
29. You are always in my presence, and I hold you by your right hand; now I will guide you with advice, and in the end receive you into glory. (Ps. 73:23-24)
