Praying this Liturgy

To pray this liturgy a leader, or cantor, makes each call (**lines in bold**) and then all respond (*lines in italic*).

It is recommended that you allow a short pause, either after each call and response, or after each set of four calls and responses, to allow the power of the words and the prayers to be received and for the Holy Spirit to speak to you through them.

May these prayers bring the love of the Father, and the power of the life of the Son into your midst by His Holy Spirit as you pray this liturgy.
